IEEP's Residential Insulation Rebate Program

As energy costs rise and climate concerns intensify, **The Independent Energy Efficiency Program (IEEP)** is seeking ways to support customers in managing their energy consumption while improving grid efficiency. Insulation and air sealing can work hand in hand to save energy, money, and to increase the comfort of homes. The IEEP is pleased to offer an easy-to-use insulation rebate program designed to assist residential customers in reducing summer and winter peak electric demands. Program highlights include:

Incentive Details

- **Rebate Amount:** Up to 75% of the project cost with a maximum incentive of \$5,000.
- **Eligibility:** Residential customers of participating IEEP/Municipal Electric Utilities.
- **IEEP Pre-Approval:** Required before work begins.

Eligible Measures include:

Attic, wall, rim joist, crawl space insulation, air sealing, weatherstripping, duct insulation, and ventilation improvements are eligible.

Process

1. **Select a BPI Gold Star Contractor:** Choose from a list of BPI Gold Star Certified contractors at [Building Performance Institute, Inc. | BPI GoldStar Contractors](#). The contractor shall provide a detailed quote specific to your home. Customer based self-installation projects are not allowed in this program.
2. Once you have selected an insulation contractor to work with, **submit the project to the IEEP for pre-approval**. Please submit an insulation rebate form, a copy of your electric bill, and a detailed scope of work from your selected insulation contractor clearly listing all work and costs separately. If approved, the IEEP will return a pre-approval authorization number and then the work can commence.
3. **Once the work is completed** and to receive your incentive, please re-submit the signed insulation rebate form, a detailed copy of the contractor's final invoice, and a copy of your municipal utility electric bill that matches where the work was completed. The IEEP may schedule a quality control visit to verify that the work has been completed.
