5. Solid Waste Contract At this time Administrator Melock advised the Board that she has been in discussions with Waste Management, current solid waste carrier for the Village, regarding the future of waste collection in the village. Liz has been informed by Waste Management that within the year they will no longer be picking up trash bags with stickers and will be switching to a totally automated tote pick up. The Board discussed the possible options for the Village for trash pickup. 
